Degrees are offered at the Bachelor level (in Nursery through Kindergarten or Grades 1 through 3) and the Master level (in Collaborative Early Childhood and Special Education). Various aspects of Early Childhood Education are of interest to other disciplines such as Education, Psychology, and Sociology.

Collection Guidelines:

Chronology: Current materials and imprints are emphasized.

Geography: The United States is emphasized. Emphasis is on North American and British imprints.

Lower and upper division textbooks are excluded. Materials with publication dates over 30 years old should be strongly considered for de-acquisition.
