D. Languages: Materials in English are emphasized.

Chronology: There are no chronological restrictions. Current imprints are emphasized.

Geography: The United States and Western Europe are emphasized. North American and Western European imprints are also emphasized.

Many of the materials in this area are encyclopedias, almanacs, and handbooks. Many, or most, of the topics are general in nature.
