Subject: A. German Language and Literature

Purpose: B. The German Language and Literature collection is primarily intended to support undergraduate and graduate research and teaching to the Bachelor and Master levels as well as individual faculty projects.

Academic Programs Served:

C. The German Language and Literature collection supports programs primarily in the Department of World Languages and Literatures. Degrees are offered at the Bachelor of Arts levels in German and Bilingual Education, the Master of Science in Bilingual and Multicultural Education as well as certification in Foreign Language Teaching. Various aspects of German Language and Literature are of interest to other disciplines such as Art, History, Music, and Philosophy as well as the fulfillment of undergraduate language requirements.

Collection Guidelines:

D. Languages: The works of major authors in the fields of literature, poetry, and drama are collected in both German and English. Literary criticism and biography are also collected in German and English. Reference resources, audio-visual materials, and electronic resources are collected in German and English.

Chronology: Periods collected range from the Renaissance to the present. Current imprints are emphasized.

Geography: There are no geographic restrictions on authors whose primary language is German. Emphasis is on North American and Western European imprints
