Subject: A. History

Purpose: B. The History collection is primarily intended to support undergraduate and graduate research and teaching to the Bachelor and Master levels as well as individual faculty projects.

Academic Programs Served:

C. The History collection supports programs primarily in the History Department. Degrees are offered at the Bachelor of Arts level and the Bachelor of Science level (with secondary teaching certification), as well as the Master of Arts and Master of Science levels. The Department offers specializations in American, Non-Western, and European History. Various aspects of History are of interest to other disciplines such as Anthropology, Art, Economics, Environmental Studies, Education (for the teaching of primary and secondary school Social Studies), Political Science, and Sociology.

Collection Guidelines:

D. Languages: Materials are collected primarily in English. Selection of materials in modern European languages is highly selective.

Chronology: All historical periods are collected with emphasis on the period from the U.S. Civil War to the present. Particular importance is placed on the twentieth century. Current imprints are emphasized.

Geography: All geographic areas are collected with emphasis on the United States, Western and Eastern Europe, Russia, Asia and Southeast Asia. Within the United States, coverage is emphasized for the New England, Mid-Atlantic and Southern states. States west of the Mississippi River are collected selectively.

Notes/Comments:

Lower and upper division level textbooks are excluded. Genealogical materials, such as birth and death records, are not collected with the exception of certain genealogical reference materials (primarily dictionaries of names). Immigrant records (such as passenger lists and registers of births) are not collected beyond basic bibliographies.
