Subject: A. Library Science

Purpose: B. The Library Science collection is primarily intended to support undergraduate and graduate research and teaching to the Bachelor and Master levels as well as individual faculty projects. The collection also serves the information needs of the Buley Library faculty.

Academic Programs Served:

C. The Library Science collection supports programs primarily in the Information and Library Science Department. Degrees are offered at the Bachelor and Master levels (as well as school media certification) and a Sixth Year Program. Various aspects of Library Science are of interest to other disciplines such as Economics, English, and Journalism. Collections of bibliographies are of interest to to all disciplines.

Collection Guidelines:

D. Languages: Materials are collected in English only.

Chronology: All historical periods are collected. Current imprints are emphasized.

Geography: The United States and Canada are emphasized. North American and Western European imprints are emphasized.

Notes/Comments:

Lower and upper division level textbooks are excluded. An American Library Association Blanket Order Plan is currently in place. Juvenile literature is selected separately and housed in the “juvenile” or “curriculum” collections. Books about or histories of specific libraries are normally not collected.

The Library Science collection focuses on book and periodical publishing, book and print making, copyright, information literacy, library technology, preservation, public and technical services in academic, public, school, and special libraries, and storytelling and the oral tradition.
