Collection Guidelines:

D. Languages: Materials are collected in English only.

Chronology: Current materials and imprints are emphasized.

Geography: Geographic guidelines are not appropriate for this subject. North American and Western European imprints are emphasized.

Notes/Comments:

Lower and upper division textbooks are excluded. Healthcare issues and policy and medical economics are emphasized. Psychiatry is of interest to Psychology and Otorhinolaryngology is of interest to Communication Disorders. Electronic format is preferred, especially for journals and reference materials. Monographs should be considered for de-acquisition 5 years after publication date.
