Purpose: B. The Nursing collection is primarily intended to support undergraduate, graduate, professional research and teaching up to the Doctoral level as well as individual faculty projects.

Academic Programs Served:

C. The Nursing collection supports programs primarily in the Department of Nursing. Degrees are offered at the Bachelor of Science, Master of Science levels in Nursing as well as the Doctoral level in Nursing Education. Various aspects of Nursing are of interest to other disciplines such as Biology, Chemistry (medicinal chemistry), and Social Work.

Collection Guidelines:

D. Languages: Materials are collected in English only.

Chronology: Current materials and imprints are emphasized.

Geography: Geographic guidelines are not appropriate for this subject. North American and Western European imprints are emphasized.

Notes/Comments:

Lower and upper division textbooks are excluded. Study guides, problem solvers, and review books are collected selectively. Nursing education and leadership is emphasized. Electronic format is preferred, especially for journals and reference materials. Monographs should be considered for de-acquisition 5 years after publication date.
