**Subject:** A. Other Languages and Literatures

**Purpose:** B. Foreign languages and literatures not specifically taught at the University are collected to provide well-rounded collections of literary and dramatic works and thought in order to fulfill the basic needs of an academic institution.

**Academic Programs Served:**

C. The collections of other foreign languages and literatures support a variety of programs primarily in the Department of World Languages and Literatures. Degrees are offered at the Bachelor of Arts levels in World Literature and Bilingual Education as well as the Master of Science level in Bilingual and Multicultural Education. Various aspects of other languages and literatures are of interest to other disciplines such as Art, English, History, and Theatre.

**Collection Guidelines:**

**D. Languages:** All materials, except dictionaries, are collected in English only.

**Chronology:** Periods collected range from the Renaissance to the present. Current imprints are emphasized.

**Geography:** There are no geographic restrictions on authors in this category. Emphasis is on North American and Western European imprints.

**Notes/Comments:**

Lower and upper division textbooks are excluded.
