C. The Political Science collection supports programs primarily in the Political Science Department. Degrees are offered at the Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor Science levels, the Bachelor of Science level in Secondary Education, and the Master of Science level in Political Science. Various aspects of Political Science are of interest to other disciplines such as Anthropology, Economics, History, and Social Work.

Collection Guidelines:

D. Languages: Materials are collected in English only.

Chronology: Current issues and political events are emphasized such as elections, international relations, and the current political landscape. Current materials and imprints are emphasized.

Geography: Primary emphasis is on the United States, United States foreign relations, comparative political studies, global international relations, and federal, state, and local government policy. North American and Western European imprints are emphasized.
